

HISTORY OF THE CRC COLLEGES



Since the CRC Churches International beginning in 1945 with **Pastor Leo Harris (Deceased)**, CRC Churches International has been a denominational family passionate about expanding the Kingdom of Jesus Christ on earth by creating Bible-based, contemporary local churches and ministries. With a clear call to establish a CRC presence in every nation by 2045—the centenary of the CRC’s founding in Australia—this vision has guided the movement’s growth and mission.

An international movement was birthed when small groups of Holy Spirit-inspired and activated Christians experienced explosive growth, fulfilling **Matthew 28:19**: *“Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptising them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”* The CRC has helped people from all walks of life not only to find Jesus but also to discover His calling for their lives.

The **International Missions Bible College (IMBC)** is a further extension of this heartbeat to raise disciples and leaders globally. IMBC is one of the official training and college arms of the CRC movement, committed to equipping believers and the next generation of leaders.

It is compulsory for all students to successfully complete **CRC739INT Safeguarding Individuals** before attempting any other training modules. Additionally, to enrol in the **Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology**, students must first successfully complete the **Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology**, as it is an integral part of the diploma training.

As **2 Timothy 3:16-17** affirms: *“All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.”* These programs aim to equip students thoroughly for effective ministry and leadership in their calling.





ORGANISATIONAL PHILOSOPHY

Our philosophy is to provide an authentic, legitimate Bible College to individuals and to local churches in an easily accessible way.

Our role at CRC Churches International Missions Bible College (IMBC) is to endorse the efforts of traditional Bible Colleges.

We are deeply committed to the concept of training people within their own local churches and areas, and to the provision of excellent teaching material and study options for Christians everywhere.

EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY

Underlying the way in which the materials are presented, and the assessment methods are used, is an educational philosophy based upon the following principles:

Christian education must stand upon a strong theological foundation ("sound doctrine" 1 Timothy 1:10; 4:13; 2 Timothy 4:3; 2 Peter 2:1-3; Jeremiah 6:16; 1 Corinthians 3:10-13; etc.)

Students must know God, not just to learn about him.

The goal is not just to impart knowledge, but rather to teach principles of sound interpretation, using the resource materials that are available.

The Bible is a self-revelation of God, who discloses himself and his glory in scripture.

Since the glory of God is mirrored in scripture, we believe that God particularly reveals himself through the teaching and/or preaching of His Word. All teaching must aim to gain an intelligent, believing response to the Word of God, leading to a life of obedience to the will of God, and of conformity to the character of Christ.

We practice "open-book" assessments, plus typically true/false and multiple-choice assessments. The combination of "open-book", true/false and multiple-choice assessments aims to instruct the student in analytical thinking and develop an ability to discern shades of doctrinal meaning.

We look to the local church to provide "field" experience, through each student's active participation in the worship, work, and witness of the church.

CRCPRT001 Safeguarding Individuals

CRC supports the precedence of child and vulnerable adults abuse prevention over prosecution of culprits, because prevention is better than cure; though in practice the two ought to go hand in hand. CRC also considers Child Abuse a violation of human rights and abhors it due to the way it causes emotional, physical, and spiritual trauma to its victims. Therefore, this policy is our organization's deliberate effort to protect children and vulnerable adults as a deterrent measure and is our organization's resolve.

Implementation of the policy will also afford CRC, its leaders, staff, consultants, contractors, partners, volunteers and visitors, an opportunity to learn from the gained experiences of others for use in contributing to the existing body of knowledge for protecting children and vulnerable adults.

CRC has a "zero tolerance" towards child and vulnerable adults abuse, harassment, or neglect. This is also a manual for use by CRC workers, volunteers, supporters, leaders, employees, consultants, partners, and visitors regarding the protection of children and vulnerable adults, by equipping them with dos and don'ts.

Therefore, the policy is for guiding its leaders, staff, consultants, visitors, partners, and volunteers who have been entrusted with providing care to children and/or youths under eighteen years of age and vulnerable adults, when interacting with them on behalf of the CRC.

This course is for those who desire to live a life following the example of Jesus Christ. It is empowering, Holy Spirit led, highly practical and Biblically based training, and is the CRC Churches' mission and foundation. Set upon the foundation of fostering greater intimacy with God, from where all ministry expression flows, it prepares students for active Christian service. The Safeguarding Individual is a 1 -2 days course and should be done through face to face training.

Children's ministry must be a central part of church life, not an afterthought. Opening our hearts to children builds a community of love and faith that extends to future generations.

The Freedom and Healing course runs over 6-9 months.

The modern church seems to be largely focused on things such as leadership, growing the numbers in their congregations, or church planting. However, it seems to be very little focus on healing ministries and as a consequence the doctors are the first port of call for physical problems.

The focus appears to be that time spent is on presentation and how things look, that dealing with the subsurface problems of the church may never be addressed. Often times when people are trained in leadership, and develop or release gifts but don't deal with the unresolved issues in their lives, is this just building on sand? However when the focus is on people being set free, the gifts and leadership come with motivation that God is pleased to bless.

If the church is to be stable, then there is a need to consider spending a more time on working below the water line and sorting out the areas that are not always visible.

Provide coaching and motivation

For those who are continuing from Certificate, or who enter into the course with advanced standing, the Diploma of Christian Ministry and Theology continues and extends the students' skills in learning, enhancing their faith in and understanding of God's Word and will for their ministry and at a corporate level.

The course includes a broad range of challenging, faith building, and Biblically-based studies relevant for personal, pastoral, church and community life. Students will learn to apply Biblical principles to their daily lives, and gain the ability to explain and share those Christian truths with others.

This course is designed to train effective Christian Ministry in His Church locally and abroad, bringing an ability to effectively communicate the Gospel. Ascension-gifted individuals and church leaders will be equipped in a range of Christian ministry activities relevant to the local Church, Christian organisation and the workplace.

PREREQUISITES:

- Completed the CRC Safeguarding Individuals course
- Completed the IMBC Certificate in Christian Ministry and Theology
- Recommendation of a CRC Churches International pastor Recommendation from your Pentecostal pastor
- Two years minimum active service within the local Pentecostal church
- Demonstrate some sound knowledge of the Word of God Active in pastoral or platform ministry.

The Theology subjects are designed to produce a sound understanding and depth of knowledge, and require a greater level of research in the Word of God to strengthen students' Christian life and ability to serve the Lord Jesus Christ. CRC Churches International Missions Bible College is open to those who have an active role in a local Pentecostal church and have an endorsement from a CRC Churches International pastor.

FULL-TIME STUDENTS

A student who is enrolled into the program and intends to complete one subject per month, is considered a full-time student.

Course Emphasis

A student may be able to specialise in a specific field of study such as Counselling, Missions, Chaplaincy or other while satisfying a particular award level.

THEOLOGY UNITS

We recommend that students engage with the course material thoroughly by reading it three times:

1. **First Read:** A “scan read” to become familiar with the material and gain an overview.
2. **Second Read:** A deeper, more focused study of the material to understand its theological and practical implications.
3. **Third Read:** A final review to complete the open-book assessments provided with the subject.

RESOURCES

The flexibility of IMBC’s delivery modes allows students to learn in their preferred place of study. Resources available for students may include, but are not limited to:

1. Prepared notes tailored to the subject matter.
2. Recommended texts that provide additional depth and context.
3. Experienced mentors who offer guidance and support.
4. Email communication for questions and feedback.
4. Seminars designed to enhance understanding and practical application.

STUDENT RECORDS

Student records are securely maintained in a Student Management System Database. Graduation is only granted when all coursework for each subject has been marked compliant (competent) by the IMBC Trainer and stored in the database.

- Sample work from selected students may be requested as part of quality assurance.
- Each student and their Trainer must sign a course completion form, which is then stored in the IMBC database.
- Additional records stored include copies of the student’s awards, application, and photo.

Students may request access to their records. Reprinting awards will incur a reprinting fee.

CHURCH AFFILIATION

All students are required to be active members within the life of a local church. This includes attending regular church services and participating in other appropriate church programs.

- Students must commit to service that goes beyond the expectations of an ordinary church member.
- This service may be eligible for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) credit toward practical experience units..

GRADUATION
